Hauppauge complies with all laws and regulations; pertaining to the restriction of hazardous substances in electronic products, as defined by the European Union (EU) and other RoHS conforming countries

The RoHS Directive specifies that an electrical product or component may not contain lead, except as specifically provided in the directive. Hauppauge recognizes the hazards associated with these substances. Hauppauge has been in compliance with the European directive for lead, mercury, cadmium, and other restricted substances prior to July 1 2006 mandated directive.

To meet this directive Hauppauge has actively investigated the alternatives to the use of hazardous substances identified in the RoHs directive. This includes alternate process related to printed circuit assemblies and related components.

Hauppauge in conjunction with our suppliers and component manufactures have done extensive research and evaluation on alternative components and raw materials to insure that the quality and product performance has not been compromised.

Hauppauge will continue to work with our supply chain and OEM partners in the pursuit of alternative component and assembly process to insure compliance to current and future RoHS environmental directives, such as the REACH compliance mandate January 2011)

In addition to the (REACH) compliance restriction; Hauppauge is also committed to the elimination of polyvinyl chloride (PVC) and brominated flame retardants (BFR's) in concentration equal or greater than 0.09% (900 ppm) by weight in any homogeneous material when they become banned January 2009.
